

Pets Policy

Many of our holiday homes allow dogs, however, it is on the strict understanding that they are not permitted on beds or bedrooms or allowed onto furniture. We know (from experience) how hard it is to keep dogs away from the furniture, please cover the sofas.

They should never be left unattended in the holiday home. During the summer the holiday homes do get very hot. We are obliged by law to evict anyone who breaks this rule. We know of cases where the RSPCA has been called and the dogs removed. Please ensure they are up-to-date with their flea treatment.

Dogs are not to be left in the sole care of young children.

Please clean up after your dog – respect the other guests and yourself. The park is putting a lot of effort into maintaining the public areas!

Please don't let your dog off the lead in public areas even if it is well trained, Some guests on the park have taken offence in the past..

Please inform us of your intention to bring your dog when making a booking. A charge of £25 per dog per week or short break will be charged.

We should also point out that it cannot be guaranteed that properties that do not accept pets have never had a pet, possibly the owners, occupying the property
